Q Shelter welcomes expanded Queensland Housing Supply Expert Panel

Q Shelter congratulates the new and expanded Queensland Housing Supply Expert Panel on their appointment.

‘An expanded state-wide role for the Panel is vitally important to unlock land and housing supply throughout the State where it is needed’ says Executive Director Fiona Caniglia.

‘We welcome the State Government’s continued roll-out of key measures to address the health of the whole housing system, while also ensuring there is enough social and affordable housing supply to meet demand.

‘The panel reflects skills and perspectives that are all important to housing and land supply. The combined skills and experience of this panel reflects the tone and direction set by the Queensland Housing Summit. We need the synergy and integration of various disciplines and sectors to really achieve immediate and long-term outcomes.

‘Q Shelter looks forward to working closely with the panel. We will be working to ensure that housing supply outcomes are achieved through this, and other mechanisms established by the State.

‘We need to make sure objectives are clear and outcomes are measured across all initiatives emerging from the Housing Summit.

‘Our biggest challenge is to achieve an immediate response to current need while a new pipeline of supply emerges based on population need’ says Executive Director, Fiona Caniglia.

‘The expanding role of central State agencies in housing initiatives is so important. The housing system is complex. We know that the role of various State agencies integrated with the Department of Communities and Housing is vital to success. The Housing Summit led by the Office of the Premier has helped to bring those agencies closer together across a combined program of work driving various policy and investment levers essential to success.

‘There has never been more willingness across sectors to work together on housing supply and affordability. We need to see community, government and business leaders working together to drive integrated solutions so that more Queenslanders have a home.

‘The Panel reflects this diversity and with a focus on all of Queensland will be a new foundation for practical solutions.’
